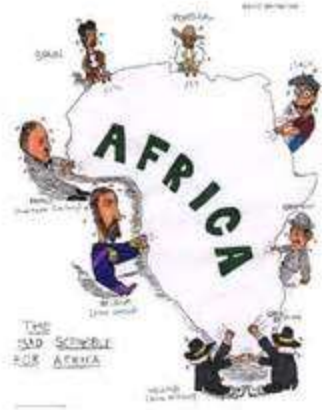


Imperialism Map Assignment

In this assignment, students will create two maps that can be used to compare and contrast the cultures and values of the Europeans and African people during the Age of Imperialism. You should incorporate **visual** elements as the primary methods of displaying these cultures. Each map should clearly and accurately display **all** of the following information. You are welcome to print and write out ideas on this sheet before making your final map to ensure that the information you have is correct. Blank lines do not mean it doesn't apply, it means that you need to research it in your notes, or on your own. While it is not required, the information in the 80 point DBQ assignment could be very useful in completing this assignment. Since this is a 4 person assignment, the expectations for quality are especially high on this assignment.
