Using plain construction paper or poster board paper students will create a movie poster for the play adaptation of the book *Animal Farm* by George Orwell. The poster must accurately represent the historical themes of Animal Farm discussed in class. Students will choose one character below to be the focal point of their movie poster. Please read the following requirements below.

## Poster must include:

- 1. Title of the movie (Animal Farm)
- 2. Release date for the movie
- 3. Movie rating, and a list of the other main characters.
- 4. A chosen quote.
- 5. A historical representation of the Russian Revolution.
- 6. A picture of the chosen character and who they represent in history.
- 7. A visual representation of a scene from the play or book.
