Extension Activities Rubrics (Assignment is worth 100 points)

Cereal Box (maximum 80 points)



Students will create a cereal box that details various aspects of WW1. Your cereal project must include:

1. On the **FRONT** of the cereal box the student must **list ALL OF THE COMMUNIST NATIONS DURING THE COLD WAR**. They must also have at least one picture (warsaW).
2. On the **BACK** of the cereal box the student must **list ALL OF THE NON COMMUNIST NATIONS DURING THE COLD WAR**. They must also have at least one picture (nato).
3. On the **LEFT SIDE** of the cereal box the student must describe the events of the **Vietnam War**. Listing one major battle, time period, and the outcome. Did Vietnam become communist or not? (Must have one picture)
4. On the **RIGHT SIDE** of the cereal box the student must describe the events of the **Korean War**. Listing one major battle, time period, and the outcome. Did Korea become communist? (Must have one picture)
5. On the **TOP** of the cereal box the student must have **5 vocabulary words from the unit**.

The model must have three dimensional representation.
