Extension Activities Rubrics (Assignment is worth 100 points)

Cereal Box (maximum 80 points)



Students will create a cereal box that details various aspects of WW1. Your cereal project must include:

- 1. On the **FRONT** of the cereal box the student must **list ALL OF THE ALLIED POWERS**. They must also have at least one picture.
- 2. On the BACK of the cereal box the student must list ALL OF THE CENTERAL POWERS. They must also have at least one picture.
- 3. On the LEFT SIDE of the cereal box the student must describe all of the NEW WEAPONS used during WW1 and how it affected the war. They must also have at least one picture.
- 4. On the RIGHT SIDE of the cereal box the student must describe TRENCH WARFARE AND NO MANS LAND. They must also have at least one picture.
- 5. On the **BOTTOM** of the cereal box the student must describe either the **ZIMMERMAN TELEGRAPH** or **THE LUISITANIA INCIDENT**. They must also have at least one picture.
- 6. On the TOP of the cereal box the student must have **5 FACTS** about **WOODROW WILSON** and what his stance was on entering WW1. They must also put why the United States eventually entered WW1.

WW1 Sandbox (maximum 100 points)



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Students will read primary and secondary resources with the teacher and have an on depth discussion about trench warfare during WW1. Students will then be provided a 4X8 box to recreate trench warfare based on the resources they read. This project will be done in class and graded on their historical accuracy. (THIS WAS BE COMEPLETED IN CLASS)
